

Agreement Types:

Amendment: Amendments to any type of agreement.

Asset Purchase: Agreements involving the sale, transfer, or assignment of tangible or intangible assets, each with an ongoing royalty fee.

Consulting: Consulting agreements containing an ongoing royalty payment based on the consultant's work.

Copyrights: Agreements licensing copyrighted material.

Distribution: Agreements involving distribution of products, each containing a royalty rate.

Franchise: Agreements allowing one party to operate under another party's name, intellectual property, and business methods.

Joint Venture: Agreements between businesses to jointly exploit intellectual property.

Know-how: Agreements to use know-how, 'closely-held' information, often found in conjunction with the licensing of technology or patents.

Liabilities: Agreements containing royalty payments in exchange for debt settlements, promissory notes, or loans related to licenses of intellectual property.

Marketing: Agreements allowing a party to market products, typically for a royalty based on the marketer's ongoing sales.

Mineral Rights: Agreements providing licenses related to natural resources, including minerals, hydrocarbons, water, and geothermal resources.

Option: Agreements providing options to obtain a license grant.

Patent: Agreements licensing rights to patented intellectual property.

Process: Agreements licensing the use of a process.

Proprietary Information: Agreements licensing confidential proprietary information, such as data or formulas.

Research: Agreements to support or provide research and development.

Services: Agreements ranging from employment services to research services to mineral rights exploration services and beyond, each with an ongoing royalty rate.

Shares: Agreements providing a royalty in exchange for the purchase of shares.

Software: Agreements licensing the right to use and/or resell or sublicense software.

Sublicense: Agreements in which a party that is a licensee from the primary IP holder further licenses the rights to a 3rd party.

Supply: Agreements to supply another party with parts or products, in exchange for a royalty.

Technology: Agreements licensing rights to use unpatented technology and related intellectual property.

Trade Name: Agreements licensing rights to use a party's trade name.

Trademark: Agreements licensing rights to use a party's trademark.

Web Content: Agreements to license works to be used on websites.
